Student must be a senior for the 2024-2025 academic school year, and attend the following schools: Woodmore High School, Genoa Area High School, Gibsonburg High School, and Eastwood High School. Applications will also be considered for any student whose parent/parents work for Martin Marietta Magnesia Specialties Woodville facility, regardless of the school district they attend. To be considered, the student must have demonstrated academic excellence in high school and have plans to complete a college education in a science, technology, engineering, or math discipline in an accredited school. It is recommended that the student have a minimum 3.5 grade point average; however, all criteria are not absolute.

Selection will be based on achievement and academic record during high school, submitted essay, and community activities. Leadership experience is preferred, but not a requirement.
